Director's Message

Written by David Yazbek and Jeffrey Lane, *Dirty Rotten Scoundrels* is based on the 1988 film of the same name which starred Michael Cane and Steve Martin. It is set in the colorful world of the French Riviera. Master con-artist Lawrence Jameson makes a living tricking old, rich ladies into giving him their money. When Freddy arrives on the French coast, he challenges the status quo, and Lawrence's position as chief con-artist is threatened. As they decide the town just isn't big enough for the two of them, they challenge each other to a bet. The first one to swindle \$50,000 wins. As they both take on the bet, they fall for the same woman, but quickly realize that they may have bitten off more than they can chew...

The original Broadway production starred John Lithgow as Lawrence along with Norbert Leo Butz as Freddy. Sherie Rene Scott starred as Christine Colgate, alongside Joanna Gleason as Muriel Eubanks. It was nominated for 11 Tony Awards, including Best Musical, Best Book and Best Score, as well as creative nominations for Best Direction, Choreography, Lighting Design and Orchestrations.

I had the pleasure of seeing a production of *Dirty Rotten Scoundrels* a few years ago and instantly fell in love with all of the little plot twists along the way. My favorite one is when....... Oh wait, you'll find out soon enough.
