## Director's Message

As I was researching hilarious comedies for community theater, I came across *Leading Ladies*, written by Ken Ludwig. I knew Ludwig's works, having directed his *Lend me a Tenor* a couple of decades ago for the Players and playing the lawyer in his *Moon Over Buffalo* a few years ago. So I knew that, even if *Leading Ladies* was only half as funny as these two plays, then I would be happy. It turns out that I am ecstatic.

Set in York, Pennsylvania, in the late 1950s, *Leading Ladies* focuses on two English Shakespearean actors, Jack and Leo, who find their careers in a rut. What ensues is mistaken identities, men impersonating women, women impersonating men, long-lost cousins, fast action, slapstick humor, absurdity, outlandish situations, and downright silliness. If these characteristics interest you, then you will really like this show. If you don't, then you should get a pie in the face and move on. I love silliness. Those who know me, including my wife, are nodding their heads in agreement.

Speaking of my wife, I thank Bonnie for her work on the costumes and set design and for her patience as I headed off many nights for rehearsals. I thank Debby Nagel and Bonnie for their work in designing the set, and I thank Sammy Barnes for managing the stage. All involved with props, sound, lighting, publicity, and other aspects of the production have my sincerest gratitude.

I dedicate the show to my father, who turns 100 on February 11, 2023. His sense of humor, energy, faith, and energy have been an inspiration. He has been a great role model. His nickname for me is Arizona because I am his number Tuscon. See where I get it from?

Finally, thank you for coming, and because you are here, I am giving you a part in the show. In Act I, Scene 2, you will be playing members of the Loyal Order of the Moose.
